Job Summary:

To provide behavioral/mental health services in the home, school, communities and in clinic to children, teens, adults and families.

Minimum Qualification:

- **Therapist I:** Master's degree in Mental Health, Community Counseling, Psychology, Social Work, or similar discipline at the time of the interview, under clinical supervision and actively working toward licensure. *Apply for and obtain at minimum licensure within 1 Year of hire.*
- **Therapist II:** Associate Licensed Social Worker, Marriage and Family Therapist, and Professional Counselors (LMSW, APC, AMFT) under clinical supervision actively working towards licensure for LPC, LCSW, LMFT. Also, *CAII or MAC Certification*
- **Therapist III:** Fully Licensed Clinician, Fully Licensed Social Worker, Marriage and Family Therapist, and Professional Counselors (LCSW, LPC, LMFT). Also, *CAII or MAC Certification*
- **Contractor:** Fully Licensed Clinician with an active Tax ID and active compliant Business License.

Responsibilities:

- Complete Biopsychosocial Assessments and Individualized Treatment Plans (Treatment Plan updates)
- Assess, evaluate, and make recommendations for quality service delivery
- Administer CANS/ANSA; Columbia Suicide Risk Assessment; SAD Person; PHQ; PTSD rating scale; short mood and feeling questionnaire and other evidenced based assessment tools as needed
- Utilizing Evidenced-Base Treatment (CBT, DBT, MI, SFT, Family Systems, Structural Family Therapy, and/or similar modalities)
- Conduct individual and family therapy sessions to assist consumers and families with increasing stability, decreasing risk factors, and crisis prevention
- Respond to agency and consumer phone calls/voicemails and emails within 24 hours
- Coordinate care utilizing a Whole Health Model (Emotional/Psychological, Medical, Educational, Recreational, Social/Leisure, Academic)
- Monitor treatment plan and ensure that it is implemented with consumer(s)
- Complete progress & non-billable notes for all sessions within 72-hours of contact
- Complete Discharge Summaries, and other QA related tasks/documents in a timely manner for all consumers on caseload.
- Attend mandatory Treatment Team Meetings, Administrative Meetings
- Complete ALL required Training
- Therapist I & II must attend clinical supervision (monthly/regular) with Clinical Director
- Attend court hearings, case/panel reviews, school meetings as deemed necessary according to Treatment needs.
- Follow agency policies and procedures as required
- Provide clinical leadership/guidance to paraprofessionals
- Other relevant duties as required by C&T Program standards for effective case management of all services for active and closed cases
- Other administrative duties as deemed necessary
